

# OSTILWELL



Awarded Best Practice by VPP The Story of Stilwell & Associates begins in 1994 when Mark Banus and J.R. Stilwell were assigned to the USS Enterprise (CVN-65) during her \$3.5 B, fouryear overhaul at Newport News Shipbuilding and Dry Dock Company.

In April 1990, USS Enterprise (CVN-65) completed her around-the-world deployment, arriving in Norfolk, Virginia, after having steamed more than 43,000 nautical miles. In October of that year, the carrier moved to Newport News Shipbuilding for refueling and the US Navy's largestcomplex overhaulrefit ever attempted.

First Mr. Banus, and then Mr. Stilwell, were assigned to manage the Navy's "Redtag" or "lockout/tagout" process onboard during the overhaul. Their initial process improvements were encouraging and the final results considered astounding. During that overhaul a proof of concept software program was written in dbase II. The effects of process improvement combined with the computer assist saved the Navy \$6.5 M direct costs and \$100M cost avoidance. So significant were the results that CNO, Adm. Frank Kelso, personally visited the LCDR Stilwell and his team to commend them for their work.

Both Mr. Stilwell and Mr. Banus, served as Naval Officers (aviators) before retiring in 1994. Stilwell & Associates of the USA, Inc, was incorporated in May 1994 by J. R. Stilwell and Mark D. Banus as a consulting firm.
